



From the NORTH and MIDLANDS: A17 & A47 Lincolnshire, Newark, Yorkshire, Peterborough, Leicester, Coventry, etc.
 On arrival at King's Lynn take the A47 Swaffham/Norwich road for approx. 1 mile from large roundabout where A10, A47 meet. Turn right to North Runcton (New Road), campsite entrance is approximately 150 yards on the left.

From the SOUTH EAST: A47 Yarmouth/Norwich, 1 mile after the village of Middleton turn left into North Runcton (New Road), campsite entrance is 150 yards on left.

From the SOUTH: A10 Cambridge and traffic from M11. At West Winch take the first right after the Church then at the T-junction turn left. The campsite entrance is approximately 100 yards from last house on right. Or, keep on A10 to King's Lynn and at the large roundabout with traffic lights and take A47 Swaffham/Norwich turning to North Runcton on right hand side, campsite entrance about 150 yards on left.
